startling facts/statistics, and other rhetorical strategies to create the context for your topic and position.		
Addresses the complexity in your topic so a counterclaim and rebuttal position can be examined later in the		
essay. Paragraph structure moves beyond the 5-paragraph form.		
Effectively develops a position on the topic of argumentation and the evidence and explanations used are		
appropriate and convincing. Every statement has undergone a logic test.		
Varies use of transition types. If you have done a good job of arranging paragraphs so that the content of		
one leads logically to the next, the transition will highlight a relationship that already exists by summarizing		
the previous paragraph and suggesting something of the content of the paragraph that follows. Transitions		
can be at the end of the first paragraph, at the beginning of the second paragraph, or in both places.
